INFORMATION, INSTRUCTIONS, AND REQUIREMENTS

The Clarkstown North PTSA is pleased to be able to offer scholarships to graduating seniors each year. This year, 12 scholarships in the amount of \$600 each will be awarded.

Students may apply for a scholarship in any one of six categories that reflect distinct areas of accomplishment. Students may apply **in only one** category; however, The **CHSN PTSA Scholarship Award Committee** may, at its discretion, move an application from one category to another if it feels the applicant is a better fit in the new category. The areas of accomplishment are:

<u>ACADEMICS</u> – For students who have excelled academically

<u>CREATIVE ARTS</u> – For students who have excelled artistically – for example, in music, photography, visual arts, film production, dance, etc.

<u>SPECIAL ACHIEVEMENT</u> – For students who have received educational resource services, or have overcome a learning or personal challenge

<u>EXTRA-CURRICULAR</u> – For students who have been exceedingly involved at North High School or local agencies/organizations. Acceptable activities include student government, athletics, clubs, etc. Community extra-curricular activities, such as Girl/Boy Scouts or Travel Sports Teams, are acceptable as well.

- 1) Applicant must have a passion for their activities;
- 2) Applicant must excel in their activities through leadership or initiative in one or more areas; and
- 3) Applicant's contributions must be impactful, making their school or community better.



INFORMATION, INSTRUCTIONS, AND REQUIREMENTS Cont'd

<u>COMMUNITY SERVICE</u> – For students who have been exceedingly involved in the community through volunteering in one or more local non-profit or charitable organizations. The community service provided must be significant in terms of the number of hours volunteered or the number of organizations assisted and the significance of the contributions made:

- 1) Applicant must have a passion for their service;
- 2) Applicant must excel in their community service by becoming a leader in one or more areas; and
- 3) Applicant must have made contributions to their community, making it a better place.

<u>NON-TRADITIONAL</u> – For students who have an alternative to a four-year college planned for their year after high school graduation. These plans may include joining military service, getting a job, or enrolling at a trade or technical school.

This application is 8 pages in length. The first 5 pages contain instructions for you and do not need to be included in your application package. Please keep these pages for your records. Please be sure to include pages 6 and 7 and your resume with your application package. All instructions and requirements must be met in order for applicant to be considered. Please take the time to read carefully.

Applications are evaluated by the Clarkstown North PTSA Scholarship Award Committee, which is comprised of at least three parents, two students, and a faculty member. Parents of graduating seniors may not serve on the CHSN PTSA Scholarship Award Committee. All applicants remain anonymous during the first round of the selection process. Semi-finalists will be contacted by the CHSN PTSA Scholarship Award Committee to schedule an interview. All information will be kept confidential. Decisions of the CHSN PTSA Scholarship Award Committee are final.

Over the course of the year, the PTSA, through the purchase of memberships, school picture proceeds, The Ram's Cave Sales, and other various fundraising activities, raises money to fund these scholarships. We are grateful for the generosity of our school community that enables us to provide these financial awards for our students.

DO I QUALIFY FOR THE CHSN PTSA SCHOLARSHIP?

To be considered for a Clarkstown North PTSA Scholarship Award, you must meet the following criteria:

- The student must be a graduating senior of Clarkstown North High School
- The <u>student must be a member</u> of the CHSN PTSA for junior and senior year and should <u>include a copy of membership cards</u> with their application. Seniors must join by <u>December 31, 2021</u>. Please go to chsnorthptsa.memberhub.store in order to process your membership online. - The student must meet the individual requirements of the category for which you are applying.
- The student's application must be complete and submitted **in full** with all appropriate signatures and supporting documentation by the deadline.

IMPORTANT DATES TO REMEMBER • MARK YOUR CALENDARS!

- Seniors must be a member of the CHSN PTSA by December 31st of their senior year.
- Applications are due by 2:00pm, March 1, 2022.
- Interviews will take place during or around the week of March 21, 2022.
- Scholarships will be awarded at the North HS PTSA Founders Day Celebration, (June 2022; specific date TBD).

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

ALL Categories

- Your completed and signed application must be submitted to the Counseling Center Office at North High School on or before 2:00 pm on March 1, 2022.
 Incomplete or late applications will <u>not</u> be considered.
- An essay must accompany your application. It must be typed, double spaced, using 12 point font, and should be no more than two pages long.
- One letter of recommendation must accompany your application. Possible letter writers include teachers, guidance counselors, employers, club advisors, etc. It must be in a sealed envelope, signed across the back flap by the writer of the recommendation, and addressed to The Clarkstown North PTSA Scholarship Committee.
- Additional requirements as set forth in one specific category of your choosing below.



APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS Cont'd

Academics Category

- Students applying in the **Academics Category** must provide a copy of their transcript reflecting a minimum <u>GPA of 90</u> with their application.
- Academics Essay Question (Choose one):
 - O Discuss a special attribute or accomplishment that you believe has contributed to your academic success.
 - Discuss how academic success alone does not guarantee life-long success.
 Include other attributes that you feel contribute to a successful future. Give specific examples of these attributes in your life.

Creative Arts Category

- Students applying in the **Creative Arts Category** must include evidence of creative accomplishments, such as photos of visual arts pieces, programs from performances, or awards received during high school for artistic and creative endeavors.
- Creative Arts Essay Question:
 - Pick an experience from your own life and explain how it has influenced you creatively.

Special Achievement Category

- Students applying in the **Special Achievement Category** must have either 1) a letter from their School Counselor affirming that they participated in educational resource related activities during high school, or 2) overcome a learning or personal challenge in their educational career or personal life that has affected their accomplishments in school.
- Special Achievement Essay Question (Choose one):
 - Choose a person, or persons, you admire and explain why and how they have helped you overcome challenges to reach your goals.
 - O Discuss learning or personal challenge(s) you have faced and what steps you have taken to overcome it/them.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS Cont'd



Extra-Curricular Activities Category

- Students applying in the **Extra-Curricular Activities Category** must include proof of involvement, passion and leadership in their school or community activities. Acceptable forms of proof can include: awards, certificates, programs, newspaper articles, etc.
- Extra-Curricular Activities Essay Question:
 - Describe your most meaningful achievement(s) and how it/they relate to your future goals.
- One <u>additional</u> letter of recommendation (for a total of <u>two</u> letters of recommendation) must accompany your application. The first letter should be from an advisor/supervisor for an activity/service in which you believe you have made a significant contribution. The second can be a more general letter of recommendation from an individual of your choosing. Each letter must be sealed & signed as described in the "ALL CATEGORIES" section above.

Community Service Category

- Students applying in the **Community Service Category** must include proof of involvement, passion, and leadership in one or more local non-profit or charitable organizations. Acceptable forms of proof include: letters of certification, certificates, programs, newspaper articles, etc.
- Community Service Essay Question:
- Describe your most meaningful volunteer activity and how it affected you and the community that you have served.
- One <u>additional</u> letter of recommendation (for a total of <u>two</u> letters of recommendation) must accompany your application. The first letter should be from an advisor/supervisor for a service in which you believe you have made a significant contribution. The second can be a more general letter of recommendation from an individual of your choosing. Each letter must be sealed & signed as described in the "ALL CATEGORIES" section above.

Non-Traditional Category

• Students applying in the **Non-Traditional Category** must demonstrate an enthusiastic interest in their chosen pathway, by answering the following essay question: *Discuss an experience in your life that led to your preferred path for the year after graduation, which will not include attending a four-year college.*


